Title: Campus Sex Crimes Prevention Act

PURPOSE

To obtain information concerning registered sex offenders' enrollment or employment at institutions of higher education, and to make this information available promptly to a campus police department or other appropriate law enforcement agency having jurisdiction where the institution is located.

SCOPE

Applicable to any person required to register under a state sex offender registration program and required to notify the state regarding whether he/she is enrolled or works at an institution of higher education.

POLICY

LDCC complies with the Campus Sex Crimes Prevention Act of 2000 (CSCPA), which is a federal law that provides requirements relating to registration, community notification for sex offenders, and the tracking of convicted sex offenders who are enrolled in or work at institutions of higher education. CSCPA was signed into law October 28, 2000, which amends the Jacob Wetterling Crimes Against Children and Sexually Violent Offender Registration Act, and the Clery Act.

LDCC's Monroe Campus has a fully functioning Childcare Center on campus. Registered Sex Offenders (RSOs) must know if they have any restrictions or limitations regarding this facility. If it is learned at any point that the RSO is in violation of his/her restrictions, they will be dropped from all classes that put them in violation and will not be reimbursed for fees and tuition paid.
