POLICY

Initial Faculty Rank

Louisiana Delta Community College follows the LCTCS policy 1.044 RANK, PROMOTION, DUTIES, AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF FACULTY AND STAFF. The Chancellor/Chief Executive Officer has authority to make recommendations for initial faculty rank at Louisiana Delta Community College for full-time faculty, to teach credit-bearing courses, by the institution in accordance with LDCC policy IN_104 Faculty Rank and Promotion. The approval of initial rank rests with the LCTCS System President based upon the recommendation of the Chancellor/Chief Executive Officer.

Minimum Rank Criteria

The minimum criteria for academic ranks at Louisiana Delta Community College are described in the Faculty Rank and Promotion Policy IN_104. These minimum rank qualifications must be met in all recommendations regarding appointment to academic rank. For academic degrees to be considered for initial appointment and promotion they must be obtained from an accredited college or university. All hiring recommendations above the rank of Assistant Professor must have approval of the Chancellor.
