Louisiana Delta Community College (LDCC) is pleased to inform you that the 2019 Spring Commencement will be held on Friday, May 17, 2019, at 7:00 PM at Fant Ewing Coliseum on the Campus of the University of Louisiana- Monroe.

The 2019 Commencement is for all students who received an award at the end of the 2018 Summer Term, 2018 Fall Semester, and those receiving an award at the end of the 2019 Spring Semester.

It is your responsibility to verify, prior to the graduation ceremony, that you have no outstanding debt to the College. Students with outstanding debt will not be able to receive an official transcript nor will their diploma be released until your debt has been cleared. All graduates who have met their degree requirements are expected to participate in the commencement activities as a condition of earning their respective degree/diploma/certificate.

**Rehearsal is mandatory for graduates who plan to attend commencement. For the rehearsal**, graduates should arrive Friday afternoon at 2:30 PM at the Fant Ewing Coliseum on the Campus of the University of Louisiana- Monroe. **Rehearsal will begin promptly at 3:00 PM.**

**For the ceremony**, graduates should arrive Friday evening no later than 6:30 PM dressed in cap and gown in assigned spot lining the coliseum. No embellishing or adorning to caps or gowns will be allowed. Only academic pieces such as honor cords (which will be distributed at rehearsal) or National Technical Honor Society academic pins will be permitted. Graduates should dress appropriately for this event. Appropriate footwear is required; please do not wear flip flops, sandals, tennis shoes, or any other overtly casual footwear.
